

Inter-League Game “Cheat-Sheet”

“A Pilot Program by GBYSL-Toiyabe Spring 2008”

Divisions these Apply to: U10 and U11/12 Boys and Girls

Play Format:

U10 B & G: 7v7 (including keeper)

U12 Boys: 9v9 for **ALL** games of GBYSL vs. Toiyabe Teams (TYB teams don't carry rosters for 11v11 play)

U11/12 Girls: 9v9 for **ONLY** those teams from Mammoth & Bishop with the **(9v9)** label by the team name.
All other games are 11v11. (9v9 Coaches may choose to play with more than 9 if their roster allow).

Substitutions: 1. Free substitutions for all games where a GBYSL team is playing! Toiyabe Teams **MUST** still observe that all (AYSO) players play at least half the games
2. All Games between two teams registered with Toiyabe **MUST** follow AYSO play guidelines for substitution. All kids play at least half game, substitutions are at quarter break (clock running) stoppage time and at the half time.

Referees: 1. The GBYSL Assignor will assign the center referee for all games where a GBYSL team is listed as The “Home” team (The team listed first on the schedule).
2. For games where a Toiyabe Registered team is listed as the “Home” team, the home team will provide the center referee that is USSF certified. The league officials will work on assigning a referee if a team does not have one available to carry the game but, depending on the circumstances, the game may be a forfeit if a volunteer referee was not certified for the team and is not present.
3. Touch line assistants for games can be from either team but are preferred to be certified USSF or Regional Referees. Parent volunteers can assist on the side lines but **ONLY** call IN-OUT of play balls. **NO OFF SIDE** calls or other calls are allowed by none certified volunteers.

Play Time: **U10**, Two 25 minute halves with 5 minutes half time break.
U12, Two 30 minute halves with 5 minutes half time break.
Quarter Break stoppage with the clock running for substitutions for games with Toiyabe Only teams. Officials may extend stoppage time on hot days at their discretion for player hydration.

Ball Size: Number 4 balls for U10 and U12 divisions. Home Team provides minimum two Game balls to Official.

Field Set Up: Home Toiyabe Teams Should set up flags at Edmonds on their field at arrival and should pick up and store corner flags if they are the last team on the field. Flag Box between Fields 7 & 9. Lock Combination: 3 full turns to the right and stop at 3, 1 full turn to the left past 3 and stop at 36, turn right and stop at 5. GBYSL Teams and Fields as per GBYSL requirements.

Mercy Rule: In an effort to maintain sportsmanship and to keep the game fun for the kids, the Toiyabe league operates under the mercy rule of “No More Than 5 Goal Differential.” Toiyabe Registered teams choosing to score more than a 5 goals differential (i.e. 7-1, 9-3, 9-0) are penalized 1 point for every goal above the 5 goal limit. We found that this rule keeps the games focused on development in uneven matches. Although we will not require compliance to these rule from the GBYSL teams, the cooperation of every GBYSL coach to observe this is recommended and appreciated.
Toiyabe Registered Teams **MUST** Observe this rule Regardless of the opposing team's affiliation!

Game reports: 1. All Toiyabe Teams must report their scores online, regardless of the outcome of the match, to the Toiyabe Website within 24 hours so we can keep accurate records.
2. GBYSL registered teams should continue to report their scores as required by GBYSL. However, GBYSL coaches are encouraged to also report the scores vs. Toiyabe teams at the Toiyabe website.
3. Referees, All Toiyabe Registered team referees should report game results on our online referee report Card within 24 hours of the match.
GBYSL referees shall continue to report matches as required by GBYSL.

Sportsmanship: AYSO and USYSA are two organizations that, although separate, work under the premises of player development. Both organizations are basically based on the same principles. With this in mind, we don't see this as an “Us vs. Them” inter-league play, but rather, we see this as an opportunity for our youth to develop while using the resources of all of Northern Nevada Combined. Please always observe the “Fair-Play” and “Good sportsmanship and Positive coaching” approach in all your games.
